Mack Glenn Hardwick

Mack Glenn Hardwick passed away on September 6, 2019 at Mercy San Juan Hospital in Carmichael at the age of 83 after a sudden stroke.

Mack was born in Start, LA to Ovin and Elsie Hardwick and grew up in Rayville, La. He graduated from Rayville High School and immediately joined the US Army. He served in the Army for the next 23 years with assignments in Germany, Turkey, Vietnam, Massachusetts, Virginia, Georgia, North Carolina and California, achieving the rank of Major. He retired from the Army on April 13, 1977.
